PROTECT YOURSELF AND THOSE AROUND YOU FROM COVID-19

- **Who can get a vaccine?**

- *As of April 2nd, anyone 16 years and older can get the COVID-19 vaccine.*

- **Will the vaccine work against the COVID-19 Variants (B117/UK – B1.429/CA – Brazil/P2)?**

- *There are three different variants in Huerfano County that have been identified. The B117/UK Variant of Concern, B1.429/CA variant of concern and the Brazil variant of concern. The vaccine will work against all three variants. Pueblo County has all four variants (B117/UK- B1.429/CA, Brazil and the South African). Since Huerfano County is so close to Pueblo, it is likely transmission is higher.*

- **Why should I get the COVID-19 vaccine?**

- *The COVID-19 vaccination will help keep you from getting the virus. COVID-19 vaccines were evaluated in clinical trials and have been approved because those studies show that the vaccine significantly reduces the probability of contracting the virus. Based on what has been proven about vaccines for other diseases, the COVID-19 vaccine may help keep you from getting seriously ill, even if you do get the virus. Getting vaccinated also may protect people around you – particularly those at greater risk for severe illness from COVID-19. Vaccines to prevent COVID-19 are perhaps the best hope for ending the pandemic.*
