# Community Health Needs Assessment

A CHNA refers to a state, tribal, local, or territorial health assessment that **identifies key health needs** and issues through **systematic, comprehensive data collection and analysis.**

# Public Health Improvement Plan

A PHIP is a **long-term, systematic effort to address public health problems** based on the results of community health assessment activities and the community health improvement process.

- Response frequencies with corresponding 95% confidence intervals
  - For combined results: Margin of Error <5%

# Who did we hear from?

- 406 responses
  - 2% of eligible respondents from each county
  - 76% female
  - 23% male
  - ~1% prefer not to say

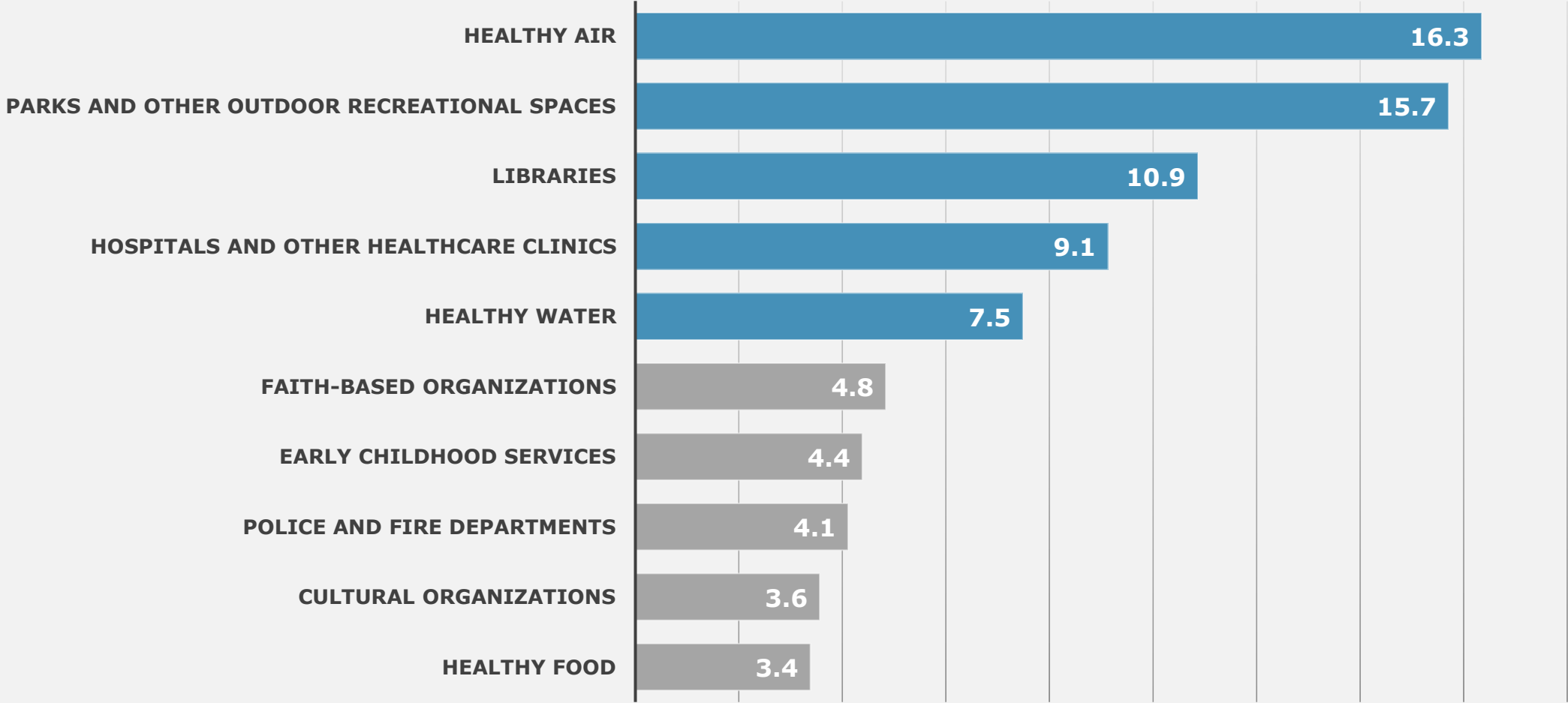

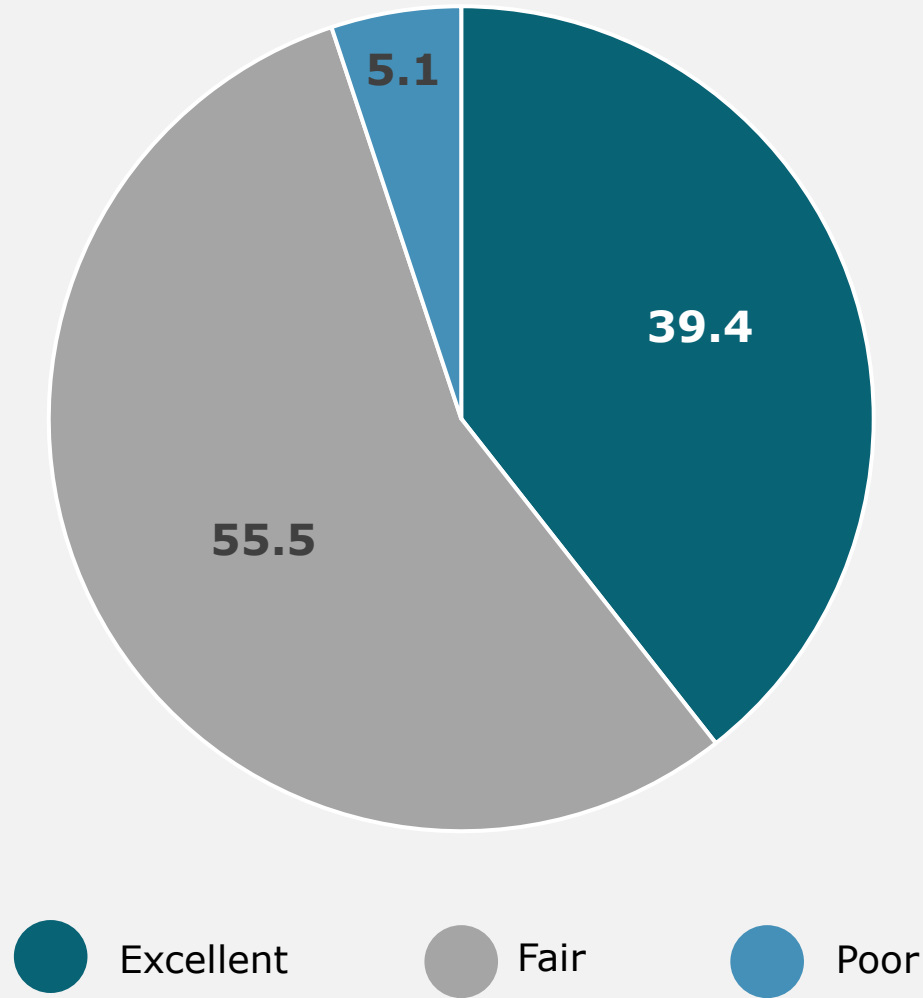

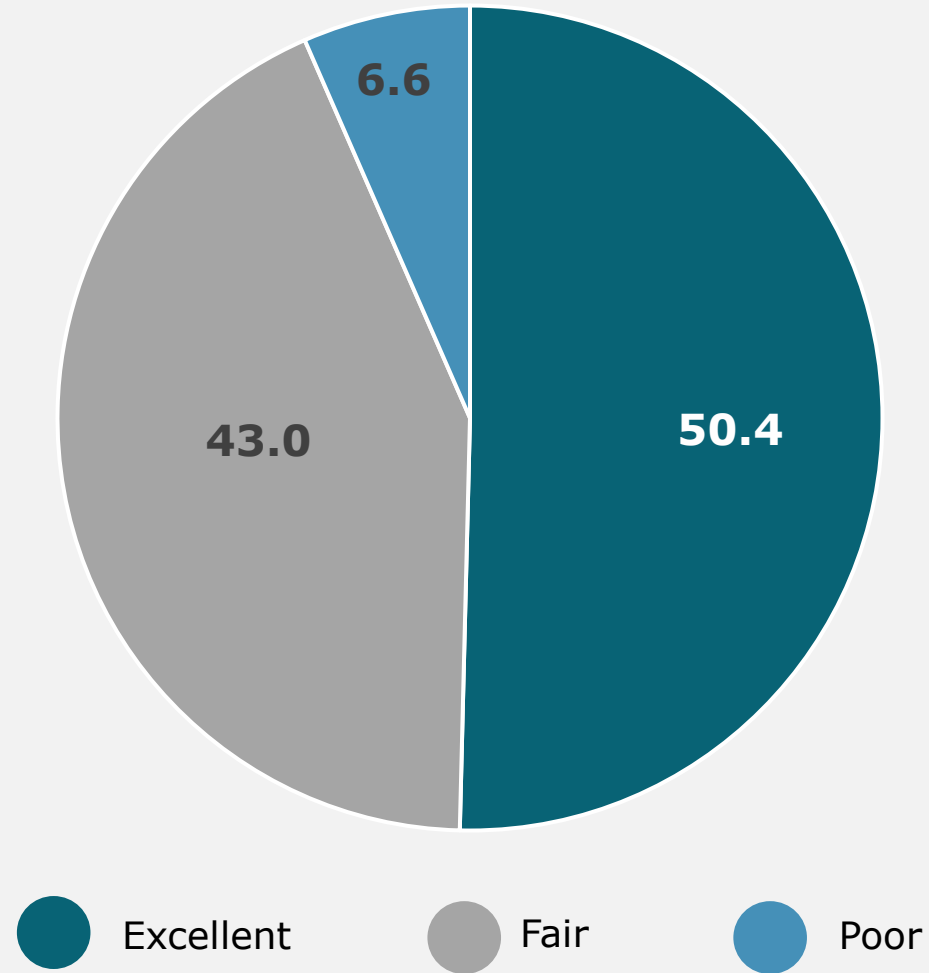
# Individual current health status

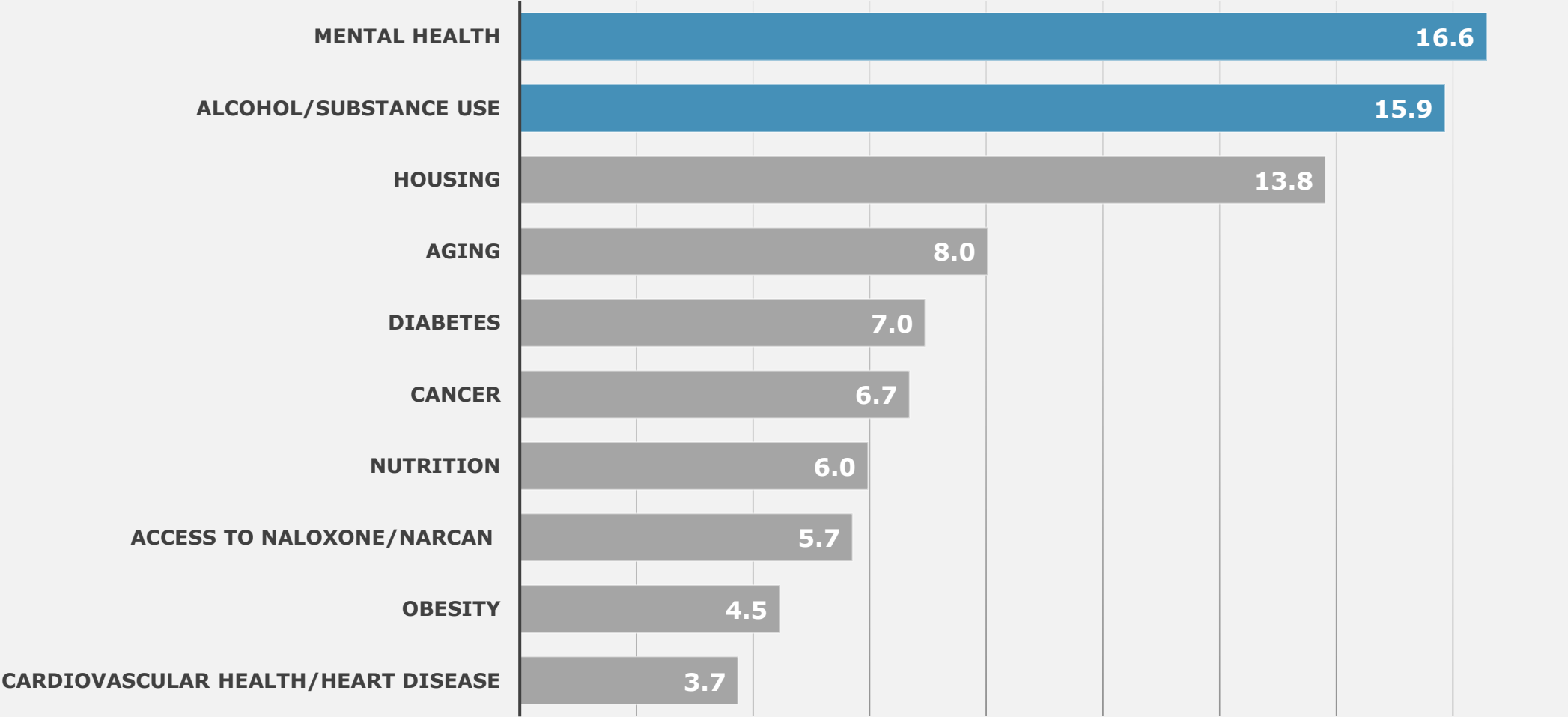

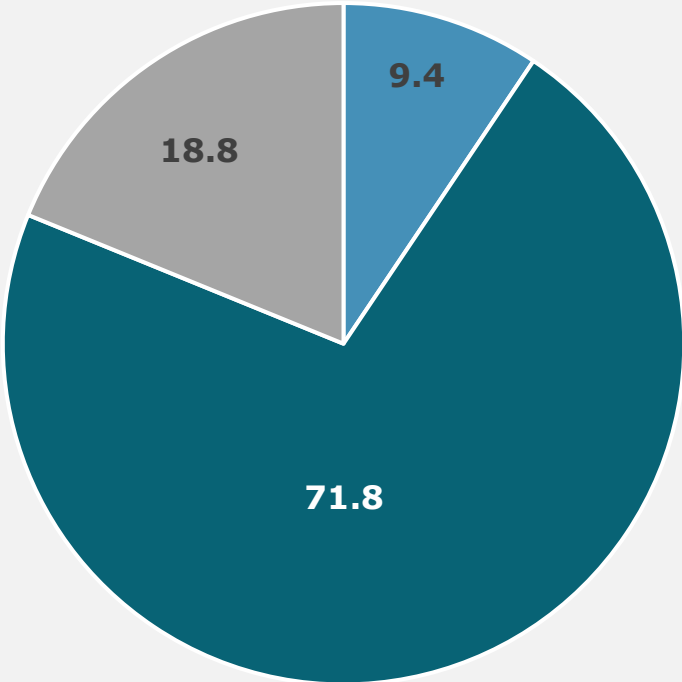

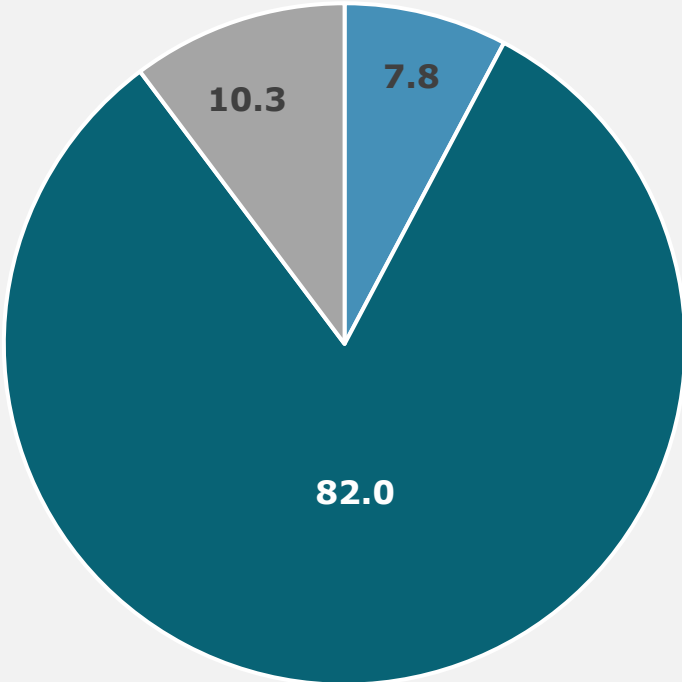

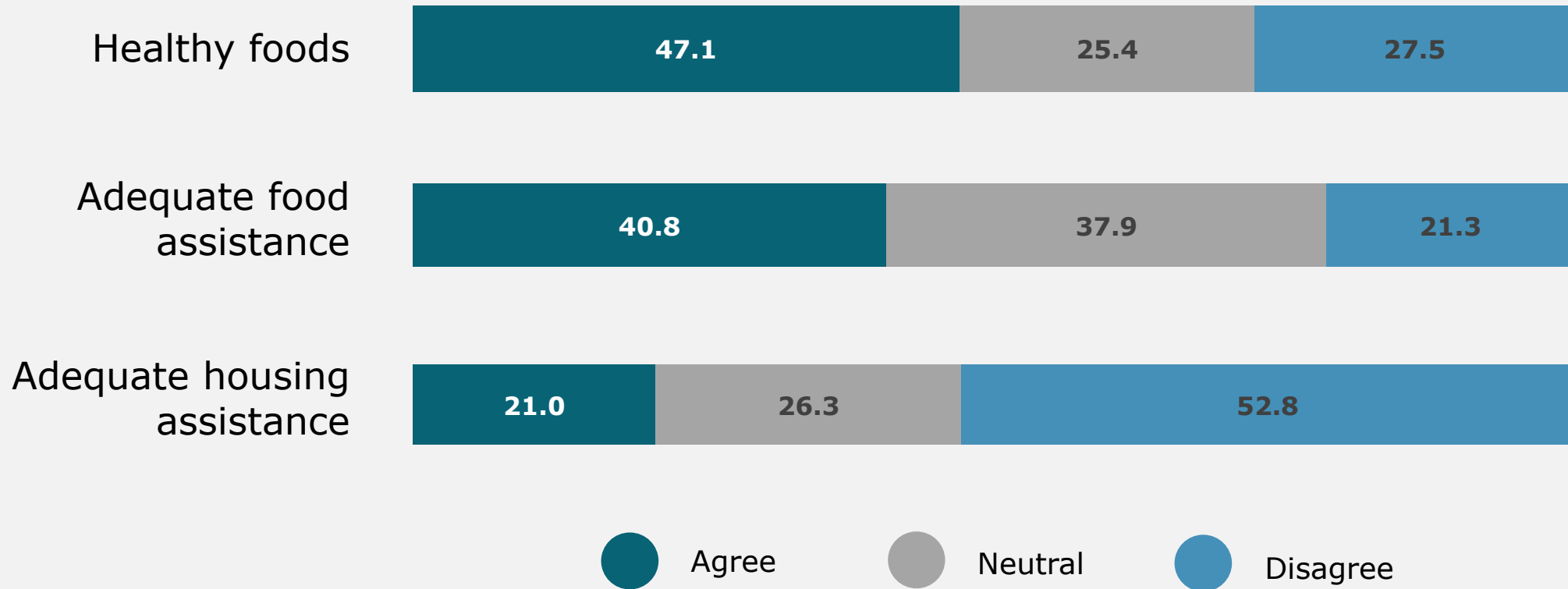

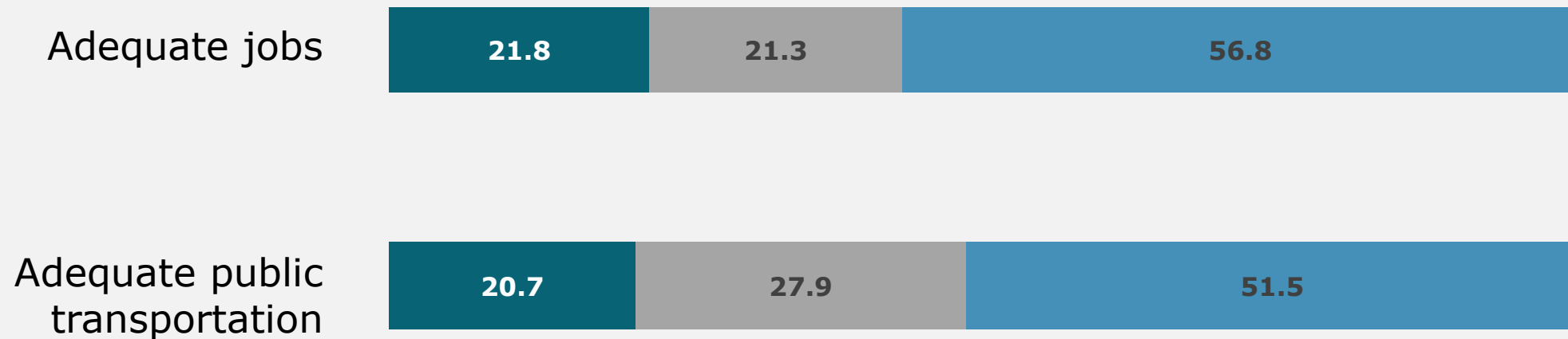

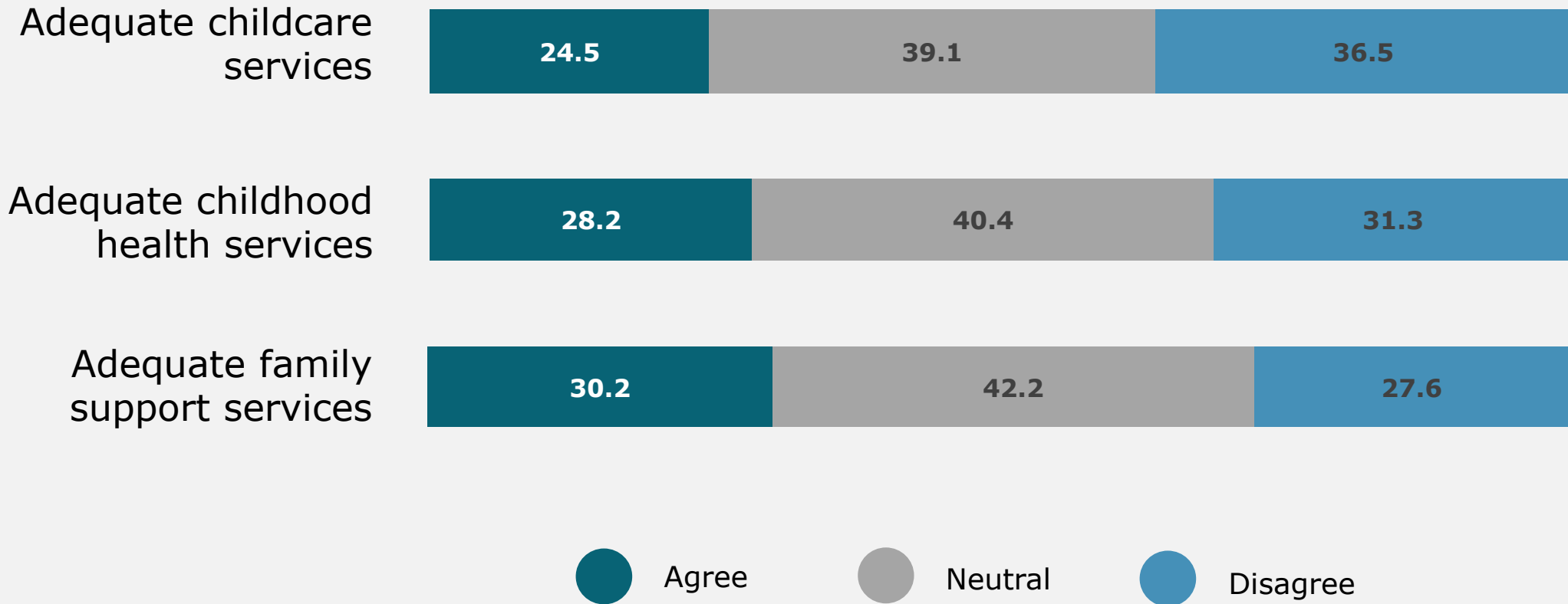

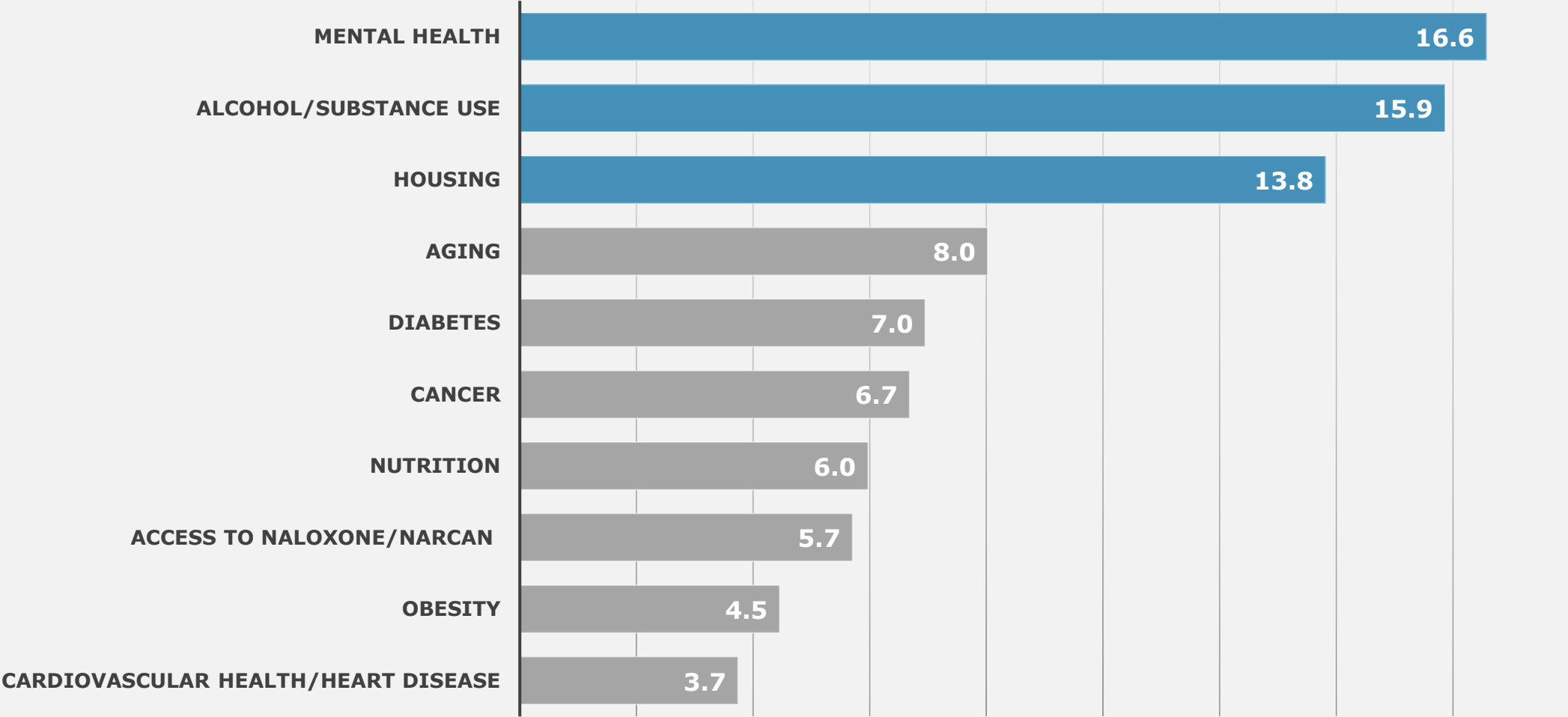

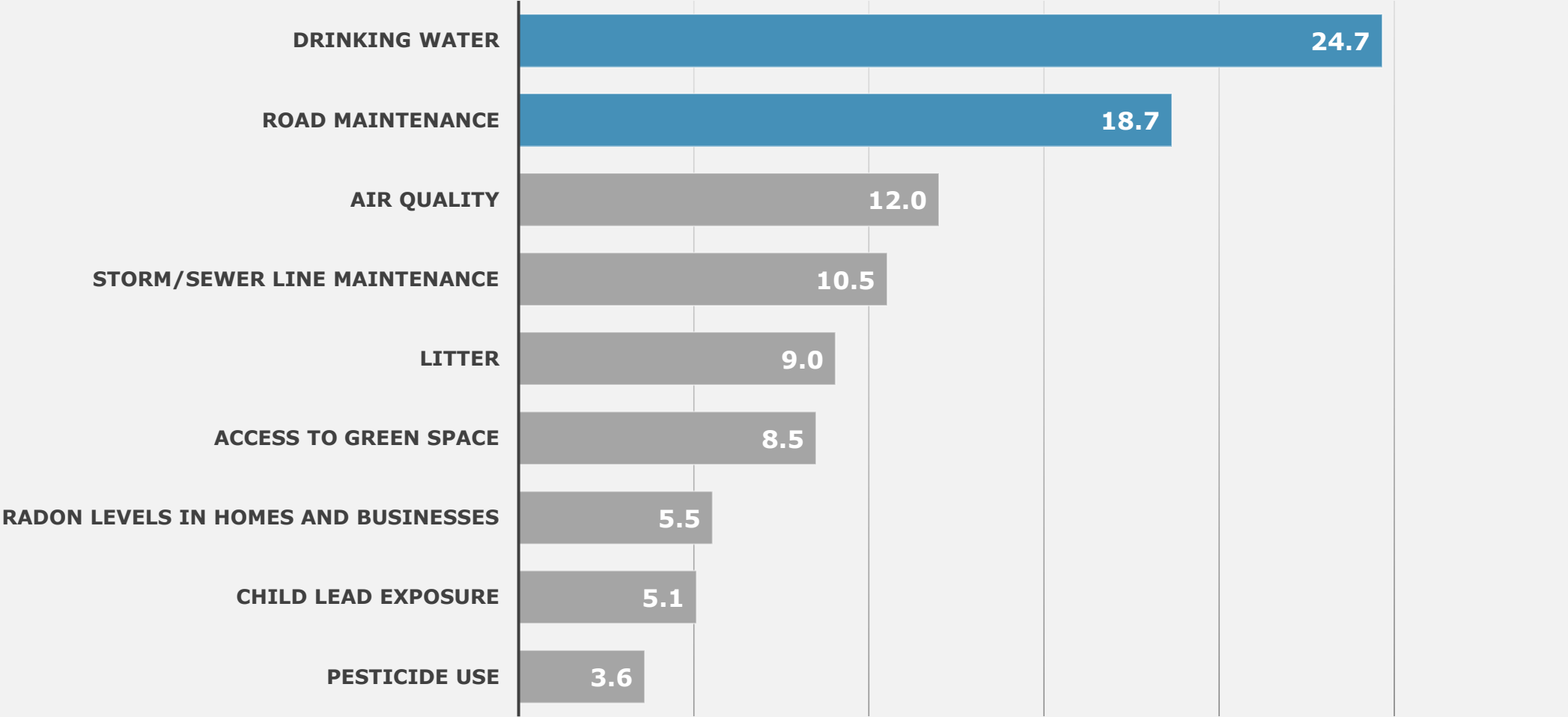

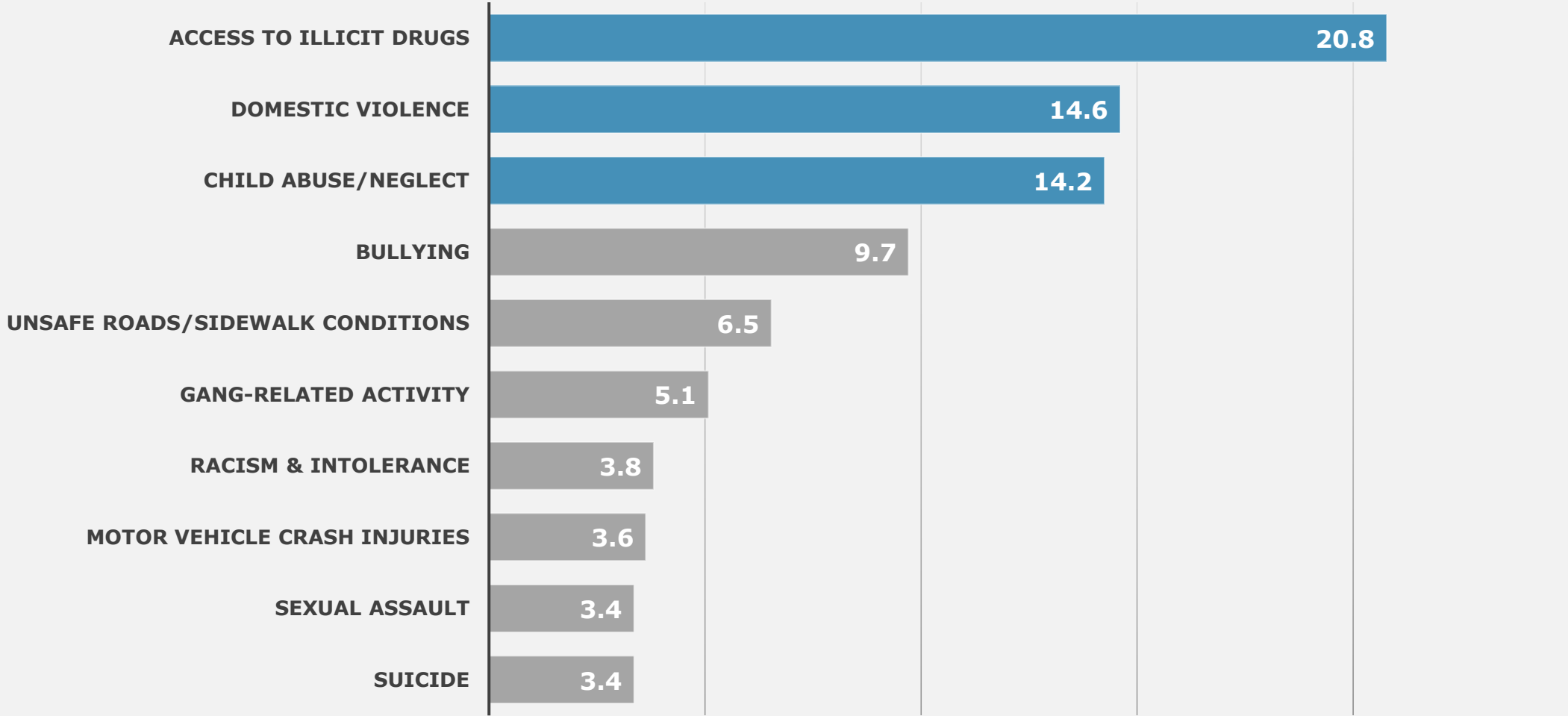
# Environmental priorities
