Community Health Needs Assessment

A CHNA refers to a state, tribal, local, or territorial health assessment that **identifies key health needs** and issues through **systematic, comprehensive data collection and analysis.**

A PHIP is a **long-term**, **systematic effort to address public health problems** based on the results of community health assessment activities and the community health improvement process.

 - 76% female
 - 23% male








Individual current health status



Current mental health status




Health priorities (top 10)




Health priorities (top 10)
