UPDATE Safer at Home and In the Vast, Great Outdoors Public Health Order

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment has adopted the Eighth Amended Public Health Order Safer at Home and in the Vast, Great Outdoors, effective June 30, 2020 and expire 30 days from June 30, 2020.

Some key changes are:

- Effective June 30, 2020, professional sports may resume pre-season practices, training and league play after they submit a reopening plan that details their disease prevention and mitigation strategies to the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment and receive approval.
- Effective July 1, 2020, paragraph 2 in this Section II.C is rescinded, and only Bars that offer food from a licensed retail food establishment for on-premise consumption and follow the Restaurant requirements in Appendix I of this Order, including seating all patrons at tables a minimum of 6 feet apart, may operate up to 50% of the posted occupancy limit or 50 patrons indoors, whichever is less.

Changes to Appendix's:

- Appendix A: removed restriction on libraries to curb-side only
- Appendix B: allowed real estate open houses to occur in accordance with Indoor Event requirements
- Appendix D: removed the reference to open houses being prohibited
- Appendix I: limited in-person bar services to bars that serve food from a retail food establishment

Unless an establishment is covered under the current Las Animas and Huerfano Counties Variance, the Safer At Home 8th Amendment must be followed. For these establishments covered by the current variance, if the current variance does not address a specific issue, then the Safer At Home PHO 20-28 8th Amendment must be followed.
